Soprano

Born in Singapore, Cherie first started in opera by winning 1st prize in the NAFA Vocal Competition 2017, the 2nd prize in the 7th Tan Ngiang Kaw/Tan Ngiang Ann Vocal Competition, and the Gold Award in the 5th Bangkok Opera Singing Competition. She graduated from NAFA with a distinction in Diploma in Music, and completed her Bachelor degree from the Royal College of Music, London.

Cherie has performed in Austria, UK, Malaysia and Taiwan, and has also worked with local music companies like the Singapore Symphony Orchestra, Singapore Lyrics Opera, Ding Yi Music Company, Chamber Sounds, NAFA New Music Ensemble, Singapore Pocket Opera Theatre, Hallelujah Oratorio Society, and many others.

She had also been invited to be the soprano soloist in the world debut of Dr Zechariah Goh's work, *Songs of the Dragon Kiln*. Her operatic performances include playing "Girl" in the premiere of Dr Chen Zhang Yi's chamber opera, *Window Shopping*, in 2014. She also played the "Sandman" and "Dew-fairy" in Engelbert Humperdinck's *Hansel and Gretel*, as well as the role of Chloé from Offenbach's *Daphnis et Chloé*.
