Korean opera singer Jee-Hye Han has emerged as one of the most exciting and dramatic sopranos of her generation. At the age of 28, she sang her first performance of the extremely demanding role of Turandot in Puccini's posthumous masterpiece at the Hungary State Opera in Budapest – a singular sensation in the world of opera.

In 2009, Han won the 2nd Prize in both the Tagliavini Competition in Austria and the Dong Ah Competition in South Korea, as well as the Audience Prize of the Belvedere Competition in Vienna. She also won the 1st Prize at the Concours International Opera de Marseille in 2010. Since then, she has performed in many prestigious houses with a repertoire comprising works by Beethoven, Wagner, Verdi and Puccini.
